Our Immanuel Church Council has called for Church Conference / Congregational Meeting on November 19, at 4:00 p.m. for two purposes only:

- Election of lay leaders / church officers, and ministry team members for 2024.
- Vote about possible affiliation with the Global Methodist Church (GMC).

After months of careful and prayerful consideration, both our Vision and Discernment team and our Church Council have unanimously voted to recommend to our congregation that Immanuel affiliate with the Global Methodist Church. Please see our website at www.immanuel-nky.org for more information.

Our gathering will include a time of worship and warm fellowship with your church family, and we expect the spirit to be positive and encouraging. We hope and pray you will make every effort to attend.

**Eligibility to vote will be limited to full members of Immanuel
(we will use an honor system).**

Please arrive early if possible - the doors will be open at 3:15 p.m. (additional parking will be available at the City of Lakeside Park City Building).

- Our ballot about affiliation will be to either vote YES to affiliate with the Global Methodist Church (effective January 1, 2024).
- Or - NO - to not affiliate with the GMC (this means Immanuel would become an independent / non-denominational church for the foreseeable future).
- The GMC vote will be by confidential paper ballot. Results will be announced at the meeting.
- This vote will require only a simple majority of the full members voting.

The GMC requires the following motion to be used by all churches voting on affiliation:

- *"I move that IMMANUEL Church become a member congregation of the Global Methodist Church, that it affirms and endorses the doctrinal standards (Part One), Social Witness (Part Two), and church governance of the Global Methodist Church as set forth in its Transitional Book of Doctrines and Discipline, and agrees to be accountable to such standards, witness, and governance. Our leadership and trustees are authorized to take all actions necessary to implement this motion."*

We will also be electing lay leaders / church officers for 2024 and ministry team members (hand vote). You can find the Nominations Report at our Church Conference link on our website homepage.

You must come to the meeting to vote (Early voting options ended on Friday November 17).

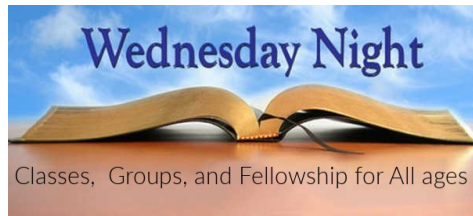

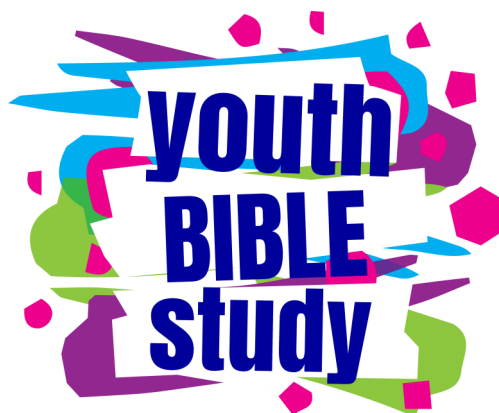
